- **Seek God's Presence:** Prioritize relationship over requests.
- **Pray for Perseverance:** Ask God for strength to endure, not just for the storm to cease.

2. Am I seeking God's gifts or God Himself?
3. How can I shift my focus from my circumstances to Christ's faithfulness?
