Discerning the True from the Counterfeit

Key Scripture:

1 Corinthians 3:11 – *“For no one can lay any foundation other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ.”*

Today’s Takeaways:

- **God’s plans are often hidden in humility.** The world expected a king in a palace; God sent a Savior in a manger.
- **The enemy always offers counterfeits.** From temptations to lies, he tries to copy God’s work to lead us astray.
- **Jesus is the only true foundation.** Religion is humanity reaching for God; the Gospel is God reaching for humanity.
- **Being “born again” means a total foundation shift.** We move from trusting the world to trusting Christ in everything.
- **We need spiritual sight to live this out.** Ask God to help you see your life from His perspective.

Affirmation of Faith:

“My life is built on Jesus Christ. No temptation, lie, or worldly system can shake my foundation. I walk by faith, not by sight.”

Reflection Questions:

1. What “counterfeit” has been tempting me lately (e.g., security in money, approval from others, etc.)?
2. How can I strengthen my spiritual vision this week through prayer and God’s Word?
3. In what area of my life do I need to more fully trust Christ as my foundation?

Closing Prayer:

“Heavenly Father, thank You for giving us Jesus, the only solid foundation for our lives. Help us to build everything on Him and to see our lives through Your eyes. In Jesus’ name, Amen.”
